



# CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

*In order for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable summer, all campers must demonstrate good behavior and respect for others by following these basic rules.*

## CAMPERS WILL...

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself
- Treat other campers, staff and visitors with respect
- Follow your counselor's instructions
- Always stay with your group
- Be kind to the environment, camp facilities and all field trip facilities

## CAMPERS WILL NOT...

- Hurt yourself or others
- Leave designated areas without permission
- Run away from staff
- Disrespect others
- Be destructive to property
- Use profane language
- Threaten violence
- Jeopardize the health or safety of others

## CAMP STAFF WILL...

- Praise, reward, encourage and listen to the children
- Set reasonable limits for the children
- Model appropriate behavior
- Provide natural and logical consequences for poor behavior choices
- Use short, supervised periods of time out

*For safety reasons, certain behaviors cannot be tolerated. These behaviors may result in a child's suspension or dismissal from the program. If such behaviors occur, parents will be notified and will be expected to support and work with camp staff.*
