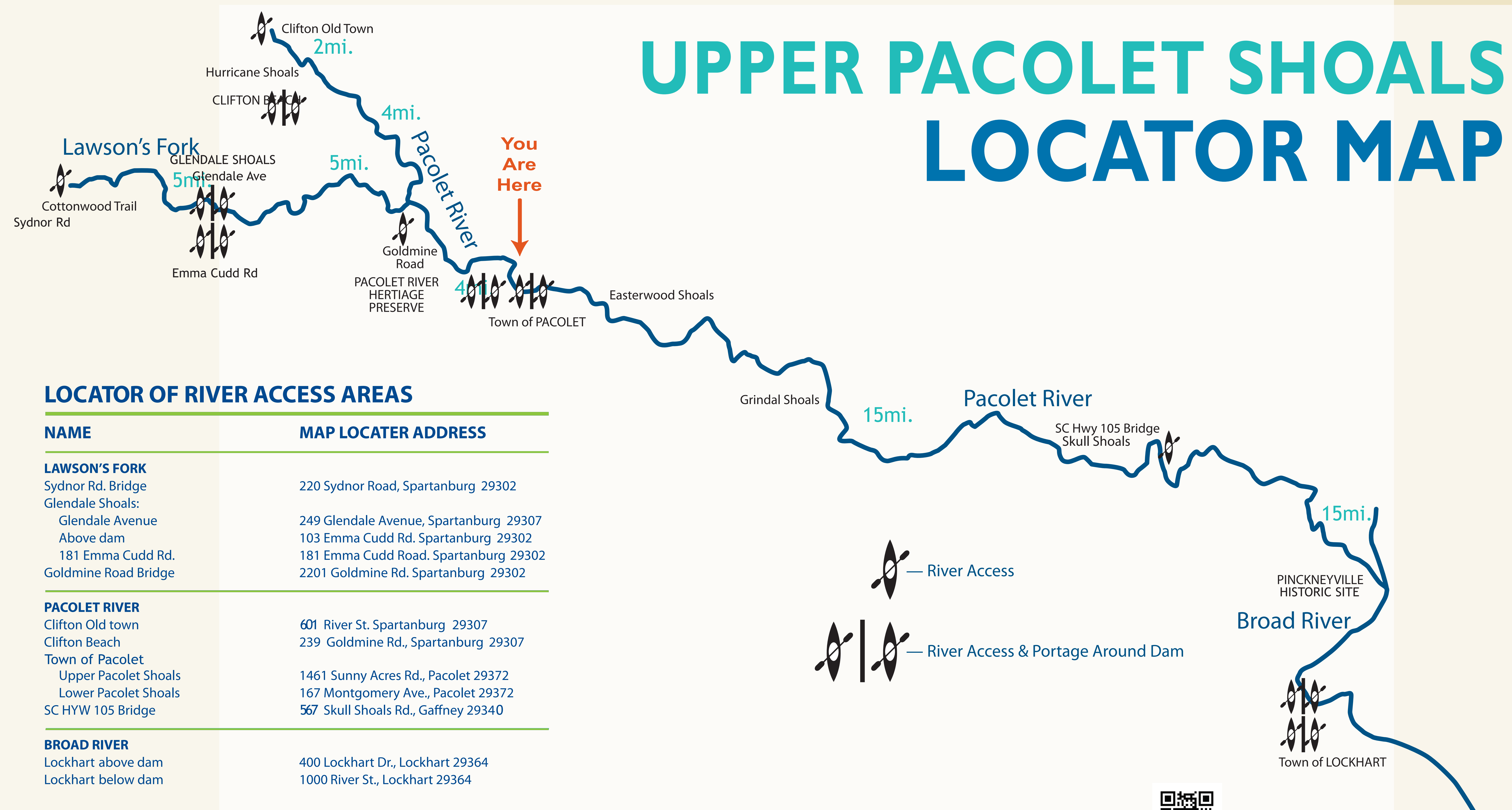




# PACOLET & LAWSON'S FORK Blueway



The Pacolet & Lawson's Fork Blueway is a project of Palmetto Conservation Foundation, South Carolina Department of Natural Resources, and Spartanburg County. The blueway consists of 50 miles of river travel and recreation that begins in Metropolitan Spartanburg both on the Pacolet River and its Lawson's Fork and extends on the Broad River to Lockhart where portage is provided to the lower Broad River.

This recreation area has sensitive natural and historical resources and the public must cooperate in preserving them and following safety practices. Please observe the following Safety and Usage Rules:

- Parking areas, access roads, grounds, trails, and river use are open dawn to dusk
- No trespassing after dark
- Obey all safety signs and information
- Stay on designated portage paths through private property
- Swim, if allowed, at your own risk
- Wear appropriate shoes to protect feet from river debris
- No motorized vehicles on river access trails
- Place litter in trash cans or pack it out
- No campfires, firearms, fireworks, metal detectors, alcohol, hunting, trapping
- Camping by permit only
- No climbing on dams, fences, walls, or building ruins
- No collecting or cutting of flowers, trees, plants
- Pets must remain under owner's control, please pick up pet waste
