## Cost

Deposit: \$45 per child, non-refundable

Weekly Fee: \$90 per child

## Registration

The deadline to make changes to your selected weeks of camp is May 15th.

Full payment for each week is due by Monday.

Your child will not be allowed to attend the next week of camp if you have not paid. You will be required to pay the deposit again to re-enroll your child in the program.

Fees will not be pro-rated for absences, holidays or election to withhold your child from field trips.

## Attire

Please make sure your child is dressed for physical activity. Tennis shoes are required.

Prior to drop-off, please apply sunscreen to your child and provide camp staff with approved sunscreen for your child to apply as needed (*form is required for this*).

## Possessions

We are not responsible for any items or devices that are damaged, destroyed or lost. We recommend your child not bring any personal items of significant value.

Please label all items, including towels, shoes and extra clothing. We are not responsible for any items left after camp hours.

## Sign In & Out

You must come into the building to sign your child in and out. Only those listed on the registration form will be allowed to pick up your child, unless otherwise noted.

This person will need to show a photo ID and know your child's code word.

## Snacks & Lunch

We provide a morning and afternoon snack. Drink machines are available at some sites during snack and lunch times. Please send them with correct change.

Please send your child to camp with a water bottle, labeled with their name.

A hot or cold lunch will be provided daily, except for certain field trip days. Packed lunches will not be refrigerated.

## Transportation

Campers will be driven to field trips on Spartanburg County School District buses, Spartanburg County Parks Department buses and/or by private charter buses.

## Activities

Character development, sports, nutrition, games, arts, crafts, fitness, special events and guest speakers will be offered each week. G and PG rated movies will be shown.

All children are expected to participate. Due to the size of the program, one-on-one supervision is not available.

## Staff

All staff members have been screened and trained in accordance with Spartanburg County requirements. They have all completed CPR, AED and First Aid training, as well as online safety trainings.

## Medication

You must fill out a medical release form if your child needs medicine while at camp.

We do not provide over-the-counter medications.

## Illness

If your child is sick or has a fever, they cannot come to camp. If they become sick during camp, you will be notified and asked to pick your child up.

Your child must be fever-free for 24 hours before returning to camp.

## Emergencies

If your child is injured and requires more than basic First Aid, we will notify you immediately, followed by your emergency contact if you are not available. Depending on the severity, we may call 911 first.

If no one can be reached and it's imperative they get help immediately, Parks Department staff will accompany your child to the medical facility.

Our staff will continuously call you or your emergency contact until someone can be reached.

## Discipline

You may be contacted to pick up your child if the disciplinary problem affects the safety or well-being of another camper and/or staff member.

Suspension is possible if your child deliberately harms another child and/or staff member, participates in the willful destruction of property or if staff cannot control your child's behavior.

No refunds will be given if your child is removed from camp for disciplinary reasons.

The following behaviors will not be tolerated and disciplinary action will be taken:

- *Foul and sexually suggestive language or behavior*
- *Hitting other campers and/or staff*
- *Insubordinate or disrespectful behavior*
- *Damage to and/or theft of property*
- *Bringing weapons and/or illegal items*

## Field Trips

Field trips are included in your weekly fee. Please check the schedule to make sure your child has everything they need for the trip.

Field trips are not optional. If your child does not attend the field trip, you will need to make alternate arrangements for childcare.

Your child will be given a t-shirt that must be worn on all field trips. Additional shirts can be purchased for \$10, if available.

We reserve the right to change, add or delete any field trips from the schedule. We also reserve the right to prevent a child from going on a field trip due to discipline or health issues.
